### Begin now to teach your children about the love of God.

Proverbs 22: 6 (TLB)

*“Teach a child to choose the right path, And when he is older he will remain upon it.”*

As the child grows old enough to talk, listen to him. Little people need to express themselves and be heard. This is part of the bonding process between parent and child. You will not only learn what his wants and needs are, you will be a good role model for listening.

**“Jesus loves me this I know, Little ones to Him belong, For the Bible tells me so. They are weak, but He is strong.”**

The time to start teaching a child is the day he is born. The first words your baby hears should be that God loves him. Sing children's Bible songs as you rock him to sleep. Repeat short Bible verses or principles to your child over and over again. Put godly thought in that "closet that is never cleaned out." Fill your child's mind with God's Word before he has a chance to be corrupted by Satan and the world.

Start Early



God places this charge directly on the parents. That is not to say that schools, churches, ministers, and community have no responsibility in the teaching of children. But what if they fail? God still holds parents fully accountable. It is your job to teach your children about God!

**“O Israel, listen: Jehovah is our God, Jehovah alone. You must love him with all you heart, soul and might. And you must think constantly about these commands I am giving you today. You must teach them to your children and talk about them when you are at home or out for a walk; at bedtime and the first thing in the morning.”**  
*(Deuteronomy 6: 4-8 (TLB))*
